ESSENTIAL SERVICES

ELECTRICITY

is supplied by the Hendon Electric Supply Company on a voltage of 240 A.C. (50 cycles). For Domestic Supply the cost is $3\frac{1}{4}d$. a unit. Power is supplied at $2\frac{1}{2}d$. a unit for the first 120 units, and afterwards at two-thirds of a penny a unit. Alternatively, consumers can pay a fixed rate, approximately 9/6 per quarter Summer, and 19/- Winter—plus two-thirds of a penny a unit on all current consumed for power or for lighting.

GAS

is supplied by the North Middlesex Gas Company at 3/11 per 1,000 cubic feet.

WATER

is supplied by the Colne Valley Company, Aldenham Road, Watford, and costs 7% of rateable value up to £40 assessment, $6\frac{1}{2}\%$ of rateable value up to £60.


TRAVEL FACILITIES

There is already an extremely good service of trains from Woodside Park Station to King's Cross, Finsbury Park, Aldersgate, Liverpool Street and Moorgate, while a few minutes away by bus is Golder's Green Tube Station on the Edgware to Morden line, but when the North London Electrification and tube extension scheme is completed the facilities will be further increased.


The Highgate line of the tube is to be extended to East Finchley, when it will join the L.N.E.R. Edgware, High Barnet lines; these will be electrified so that tube trains can run through from both lines to the City and West End.

There will be a new tube station at Highgate L.N.E.R. station. In addition, a connection is to be built between the L.N.E.R. electrified lines and Northern—City Tube Railway at Finsbury Park to enable trains to run through to Moorgate from Edgware, High Barnet and Alexandra Palace.

The number of trolley buses is also going to be increased. These alterations will enable residents to get to the City and West End even more rapidly and pleasantly than at present. At Tally Ho Corner, the junction of the Finchley and Great North Roads, there is a continual service of buses to all parts of Central and Outer London.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Electricity is supplied by the Hendon Electric Supply Company, the Voltage being 240, A.C. 50 cycles. For Domestic Supply the cost is 3½d. per Unit. Power is supplied at 2½d. per Unit for first 120 and afterwards at ¾d. per Unit. There is an alternative Rate by which Consumers can pay a fixed Rate (approximately 9/6d. per quarter in Summer and 19/- in Winter for "A" and "B" Type Houses) plus ¾d. per Unit for all Current consumed, whether for lighting or power.

Gas is supplied by the North Middlesex Gas Company at 9.4 per therm = 3/11d. per 1,000 cubic feet.

The Woodside Park Garden Suburb is situated in the Borough of Hendon, the present Rates being 9/0d. in the £ The Assessments are "D" £30; "F" £31; "A," "B" £32; "C," "M" £34; "E" £35.

The Nearest Approach to the Estate from TALLY HO' CORNER is by way of Nether Street bearing left and turning under the Railway Arch in Argyle Road; the entrance to the Estate is immediately opposite. From GOLDERS GREEN the best way is to turn down Alexandra Grove from Ballards Lane.

Country Walks. Very pretty and favourite walks over the fields lead to Mill Hill and Totteridge.
